Talk 1 – Person of Christ - Bleeding Woman

Main Points

1. She was alone, in pain, no money, no hope
2. One touch of Jesus changed her life
3. Jesus brought her faith, peace, freedom

Talk 2 – Sin – Rich Young Ruler

Main Points

1. We can have everything going for us and still want more
2. God loves us enough to tell us the truth
3. Like the rich young ruler, we want to go our way, this is sin:
 - a. Define
 - b. We all have it
 - c. Consequences (separation, death, stuck)

5. What are the consequences of sin?

Talk 3 – Cross – Barabbas

Main Points

1. Jesus died in our place for the consequences of our sin
2. Barabbas is a great example of what Jesus came to do for us. His life for ours.
3. The cross demands a response. Jesus says come follow me. Do you want a personal relationship with God?

Cabin Time Questions

1. What did you think about during your 15 minutes?
2. Are the other things that came to mind more important than what you've heard tonight? Why is it easier to think about those things?
3. Did Barabbas deserve his freedom? Why?
4. Would you die right now for anyone?
5. Describe the type of death Jesus died.
6. Why did Jesus die?
7. How did Jesus pay for the penalty of sin?
8. If you could go and look Jesus in the eyes, what would you say to him?

Talk 4 – Resurrection and Response - Mary meets Jesus

Main points

1. Jesus conquered death
2. God desires a personal relationship with you (i.e. "Mary" in the story)
3. Do you want to start a relationship with Jesus? (Like a great but not perfect family)
4. The ring is a symbol of an ongoing relationship

Cabin Time Questions

1. What did the ring make you think about?
2. Why do you think God wants a "personal" relationship with you?
3. Would you think differently if Jesus was still dead in a cave? Why?
4. Mary said, "I have seen the Lord!", how have you seen God/ The Lord this weekend? (Is it what you expected? How does it compare? Etc.)
5. Do you want to start a relationship with Jesus?
