Groups not Lines

- The best pictures are when people are grouped and super close together
- Lined pictures makes for very long images and results in little detail in everyone in the picture (see images bellow)



Fill the Frame

- When you take pictures, try and zoom or move so that the people in the picture take up the most space
- If you don't you'll end up with wasted space that could of been used to get better detail of the people in the picture (see images bellow, notice the red lines designated wasted space)



Rule of Thirds (don't center your images)

- A standard Photography and Videography rule is simple and can be applied to any picture to enhance the general appeal of the picture
 - By dividing your screen up by using the grid bellow, you should attempt to put your focus points of the picture where the lines intersect
